Candidate: The Candidate must be an Ordinary member (or honorary Life Member). Associate members are those who do not hold an appropriate "Certificate of Proficiency".

Proposer & Seconder: Both the Proposer & Seconder must be Ordinary members (or honorary Life Members). Associate members are those who do not hold an appropriate "Certificate of Proficiency". It is the responsibility of the candidate to find their own proposer and seconder, and to assure that they are Ordinary members (or honorary Life Members).

Resume: With the ballot papers, candidate resumes will be sent out to members. The Resumes are to be a maximum of 200 words and are to be forwarded to the Divisional Returning Officer, by the close of nominations. The Returning Officer reserves the right to edit back any resumes over 200 words.
